136 PRIME CATTLE

A reasonable number forward with fewer handy-weights but plenty of meat about. Best cattle held values with the “edge off” the commercial sorts ever so slightly. The cattle were a credit to producers generally, with our heifer average up on last week and in front of dead values by some margin.

Steer numbers quite constant, with some tidy shaped cattle forward selling to 223p/kg, with heavy Continentals to £1472. Best butchers heifers saw cattle around half a ton to 246p/kg, with handier weights to 249p/kg on two occasions. Several other vendors saw 235p/kg plus. All well-fleshed heifers in strong demand whatever their weight with heavies to £1403.84.

Nearly 50 bulls which is a bit more like it. Very few handy-weight suckler bulls almost extinct. Handy-weight Blondes sold to 216p/kg with Holsteins the usual exceptional trade to 173p/kg. Heavy sucklers to £1536 at 19 months. Keep the bulls coming – more buyers coming next week!

14 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 126P/KG

A super trade with some well-fleshed cows forward – every one Farm Assured.

British Blues crosses sold to 147p/kg for 716kg from Frank Millichamp, with 660kg Limmies to 146p/kg from Brian Watkins. 640kg 32 month Friesians to 140p/kg from James Lee, with Charlie Lloyd’s Friesians to £1049.60.

27 steers sold to average 180p/kg – Well-finished Limousins from John Gore topped this section at 223p/kg, with 516kg British Blues to 221p/kg for the same owner. Handy 492kg Limousin crosses took the bronze medal for Mr England at 220p/kg. 606kg Limmies sold to 206p/kg from Harold Pugh. 736kg Blonde crosses sold to £1472 from Frank Millichamp.

64 heifers sold to av. 205p/kg – Two crackers from Steve Perkins sold to 249p/kg at 464kg and 480kg. 518kg Limmies from Derek Tomley, with 520kg to 245p/kg to start Richard Parkes’ nice run – well done Parkesy, considering you weren’t attending! Roger Jordin and Henry Yates both sold to 243p/kg with heavy heifers to £1403.84 at 656kg.
